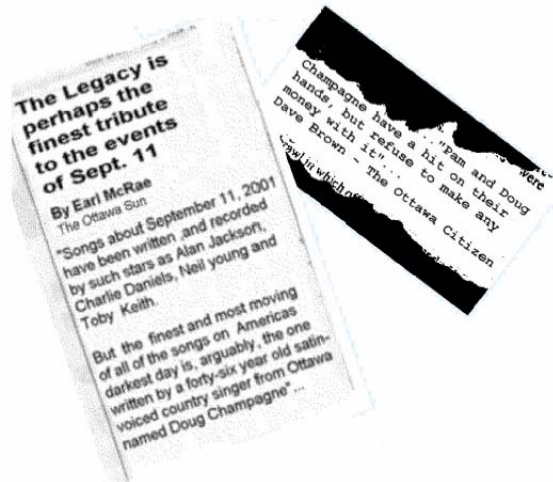


The "DOUG and PAM Show"
